

(Zechariah 2:1-4) I raised my eyes and **looked**: there were **four horns**. Then I asked the angel who spoke with me what these were. He answered me, "These are the horns that scattered Judah and Israel and Jerusalem." Then the Lord showed me four blacksmiths. And I asked, "What are these coming to do?" And he said, "Here are the horns that scattered Judah, so that no man raised his head any more; but these have come to terrify them: to **cast down the horns of the nations** that raised their horns to scatter the land of Judah."

(Daniel 8:1-7) After this first **vision**, I, Daniel, had another, in the third year of the reign of King Belshazzar...I **looked** up and saw standing by the river a **ram** with two great **horns**, the one larger and newer than the other. I saw the ram **butting** toward the west, north and south. No **beast** could withstand it or be rescued from its power; it did what it pleased...

(1 Enoch 90:8-11) Then I saw in a **vision** **ravens** flying above those **lambs**, and they **seized** one of those **lambs**; and then **smashing the sheep**, they ate them. I kept seeing until those lambs grew **horns**; but the **ravens crushed their horns**. Then I kept seeing until one great **horn** sprouted on those **sheep**, and he opened their **eyes**...Those ravens **gather and battle** with [the horned ram] and seek to remove his **horn**, but without any success.

(Revelation 5:6-8) Then I saw standing in the midst of the throne and the **four** living creatures and the elders, a **lamb** that seemed to have been **slain**. He had seven **horns** and seven **eyes**; these are the spirits of God sent out into the whole world.
